The new NETYS PL, from 600 to 800 VA, is the multi-socket UPS for simple connections - compact, user-friendly protection for home and small office applications, ideal for multimedia PCs and professional workstations. Its modern design, which also comes in an elegant white version, is perfect for installation on or below the desk or on the floor. In addition to its 6 outputs (4 for power cut protection and 2 for overvoltage) it has a practical USB port for recharging mobile devices.

The NETYS PE, from 600 to 2000 VA, offers universal, cost-effective protection for offices, IT applications in small businesses (computers, workstations, wireless networks, POS terminals). Attractive, easy to use and monitor with an LCD/LED synoptic panel and graphic icons, it runs on VI 'line interactive' technology with AVR - pseudo sine wave - which stabilises output voltage and prevents commutation in battery operation, in order to maintain the load in the event of a power cut.

The NETYS PR MT, from 1000 to 2000 VA, offers professional protection for offices and SMEs (high performance computers, CAD, routers/modems, external data archiving units and other sensitive electronic equipment), in a minitower for easy installation near the IT load to be powered and protected. It comes with LOCAL VIEW software, used to monitor and switch off the UPS, for Windows®, Linux and MAC OS X systems.

With increased power, the NETYS PR RT from 1700 to 3300 VA is also new to the range, in a rack or tower version for protecting network cabinets connected to small servers, storage units, hubs, routers, or VoIP phone switchboards. It stands out due to its versatility and resistance, and the sine wave inverter technology ensures full compatibility with any kind of load and power. Batteries are no longer a problem - these are 'hot swap' and can be replaced without switching off the utilities, including an optional extension module (EBM) to satisfy different needs for autonomy. Remote control is assured by the SOCOMECS UPS LAN NET VISION card.

Also new to the NETYS RT range, from 1100 to 11 kVA, is the sine wave on-line double conversion technology for filtering all disturbances from and to the network, guaranteeing top protection for connected services, ideal for company servers, hubs of critical importance, large network peripherals, memory units, routers, bridges, hubs and other electronic devices. The power range from 5 to 11 kVA has improved performance, from 10% to 30% more active power, benefiting rapidly evolving critical services demanding increasingly high quality for energy protection.
